1st prize: 55,0 - 60,0 points 2nd prize: 45,0 - 54,9 points 3rd prize: 35,0 - 44,9 points diploma: 30,0 - 34,9 points

Prizes:

The First Prize winner in discipline violin/viola under the condition of having more than 58,0 points, will receive 800,00 €.

The First Prize winner in discipline cello/double bass, under the condition of having more than 58,0 points, will receive 600,00 €.

The Jury may award one or more special prizes.
