

Dear competitors,

Music School Josip Hatze, under the patronage of the city of Split and Split-Dalmatia County, invites you to participate in the **28<sup>th</sup> International Competition DALEKI AKORDI** (Distant chords) which will be held in Split (violin and viola) and Kaštela (cello and double bass) between April 25<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

The competition is open to string players who will be asked to perform the programme listed in competition rules.

#### Violin and viola competition:

precategory – 8 years or younger (born in 2017)

1<sup>st</sup> category – 10 years or younger (born in 2015)

2<sup>nd</sup> category – 12 years or younger (born in 2013)

3<sup>rd</sup> category – 14 years or younger (born in 2011)

4<sup>th</sup> category – 16 years or younger (born in 2009)

5<sup>th</sup> category – 19 years or younger (born in 2006)\*

6<sup>th</sup> category – 23 years or younger (born in 2002)\*

\*Undergraduate students can only apply in 6<sup>th</sup> category.

## Program – violin and viola:

#### Precategory

- two free choice pieces

time limit 5 min

1<sup>st</sup> category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces

- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 10 min

2<sup>nd</sup> category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces
- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 12 min

3<sup>rd</sup> category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces
- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 17 min

- 4<sup>th</sup> category (at least three pieces)
  - two or more free choice pieces
  - one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 22 min

- 5<sup>th</sup> category (at least three pieces)
  - two or more free choice pieces
  - one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 27 min

- 6<sup>th</sup> category (at least three pieces)
  - two or more free choice pieces
  - one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 30 min

#### Cello and double bass competition:

- 1<sup>st</sup> category 10 years or younger (born in 2015)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> category 12 years or younger (born in 2013)
- 3<sup>rd</sup> category 14 years or younger (born in 2011)
- 4<sup>th</sup> category 16 years or younger (born in 2009)
- 5<sup>th</sup> category 19 years or younger (born in 2006)\*
- 6<sup>th</sup> category 23 years or younger (born in 2002)\*
  - \*Undergraduate students can only apply in 6<sup>th</sup> category.

#### Programme – cello and double bass:

- 1<sup>st</sup> category (at least three pieces)
  - two or more free choice pieces
  - one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 8 min

- 2<sup>nd</sup> category (at least three pieces)
  - two or more free choice pieces
  - one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 10 min

- 3<sup>rd</sup> category (at least three pieces)
  - two or more free choice pieces
  - one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 15 min

## 4<sup>th</sup> category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces
- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 20 min

5<sup>th</sup> category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces

- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 25 min

6<sup>th</sup> category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces

- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 30 min

## Scoring:

1<sup>st</sup> prize: 55,0 - 60,0 points 2<sup>nd</sup> prize: 45,0 - 54,9 points 3<sup>rd</sup> prize: 35,0 - 44,9 points diploma: 30,0 - 34,9 points

## Prizes:

The First Prize winner in discipline violin/viola under the condition of having more than 58,0 points, will receive  $800,00 \in$ .

The First Prize winner in discipline cello/double bass, under the condition of having more than 58,0 points, will receive  $600,00 \in$ .

The Jury may award one or more special prizes.
