Music School Josip Hatze, under the patronage of the city of Split and Split-Dalmatia County, invites you to participate in the **28th International Competition DALEKI AKORDI (Distant chords)** which will be held in Split (violin and viola) and Kaštela (cello and double bass) between April 25th and 30th, 2025.

The competition is open to string players who will be asked to perform the programme listed in competition rules.

Violin and viola competition:

precategory – 8 years or younger (born in 2017)

1st category – 10 years or younger (born in 2015)

2nd category – 12 years or younger (born in 2013)

3rd category – 14 years or younger (born in 2011)

4th category – 16 years or younger (born in 2009)

5th category – 19 years or younger (born in 2006)*

6th category – 23 years or younger (born in 2002)*

**Undergraduate students can only apply in 6th category.*

Programme – violin and viola:

Precategory

- two free choice pieces

time limit 5 min

1st category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces

- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 10 min

2nd category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces

- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 12 min

3rd category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces
- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 17 min

4th category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces
- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 22 min

5th category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces
- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 27 min

6th category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces
- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 30 min

Cello and double bass competition:

1st category – 10 years or younger (born in 2015)

2nd category – 12 years or younger (born in 2013)

3rd category – 14 years or younger (born in 2011)

4th category – 16 years or younger (born in 2009)

5th category – 19 years or younger (born in 2006)*

6th category – 23 years or younger (born in 2002)*

**Undergraduate students can only apply in 6th category.*

Programme – cello and double bass:

1st category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces
- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 8 min

2nd category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces
- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 10 min

3rd category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces
- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 15 min

4th category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces
- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 20 min

5th category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces
- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 25 min

6th category (at least three pieces)

- two or more free choice pieces
- one piece by a composer from the competitor's own country

time limit 30 min

Scoring:

1st prize: 55,0 - 60,0 points

2nd prize: 45,0 - 54,9 points

3rd prize: 35,0 - 44,9 points

diploma: 30,0 - 34,9 points

Prizes:

The First Prize winner in discipline violin/viola under the condition of having more than 58,0 points, will receive 800,00 €.

The First Prize winner in discipline cello/double bass, under the condition of having more than 58,0 points, will receive 600,00 €.

The Jury may award one or more special prizes.
